- 2. Applicants shall have access to a suitable site and secure water supply, waste disposal system supported by Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) and certification of EIA issued from Department of Environment;
- 3. Applicant shall have an effective, long-term partnership with a reputable international service provider for technical advice, SPF brood stock and improved technologies; and have or have identified for hire qualified hatchery technicians; and can present a viable business plan that includes state-of-the-art hatchery design, identified marketing channels and efficient operational management.
- 4. For the grant Applications under this Window, following eligibility and selection criteria will be applied:
 - a. improving the availability and reducing the price of disease-free post larvae (PL) for grow-out farms (target beneficiaries under in the project area);
 - b. reducing market incentives for illegal capture of wild PLs;
 - c. supporting the cluster farmers with technical understanding and on use of the of SPF seed (PL);
 - d. demonstrating the shift to a bio-secure hatchery technology by the hatchery sub-sector;
 - e. contribution to transforming the coastal aquaculture into a globally competitive blue economy industry at par with global environmental, social and biosecurity standards.
 - f. if partnership is involved, roles and responsibilities of partner(s) should be explained; and
 - g. Farms built on encroached areas viz. river levees, accredited chars, planted or natural mangrove patches or in illegally occupying or having legal disputes will not be eligible for the support scheme.
