

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project** and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Supply, Installation and Commissioning of VMS related Hardware and Software.
2. The Department of Fisheries now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for supply of VMS related office hardware, VMS software leasing for 3 years and providing training on VMS software operation & maintenance to 40 (Forty) officials.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016 revised November 2017" ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Office of Project Director, Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project, Department of Fisheries, Matshya Bhaban, Dhaka through e-mail address given below and inspect the bidding document during office hours i.e. 09:00 to 17:00 hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours) before the submission date at the address given below.
5. A complete set of the bidding documents in English may be obtained in electronic format by prospective bidders upon submission of a written application letter which may be sent through email from the bidder's official email address to the Purchaser's official email address specified below.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 15:00 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 26 November 2020. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 15:30 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 26 November 2020.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of USD 5000.00 (US Dollar Five Thousand only) or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency as per the requirements detailed in the bidding documents.
8. A pre-bid meeting will be held at 15.00 Hours (Local time- GMT+06:00Hours), 1 November 2020 at the address given below. Interested bidders are requested to attend the meeting. In view of constraints on account of COVID-19 pandemic, the pre-Bid meeting will be conducted virtually through live video conference, for which electronic connection link will be sent by the Purchaser at least seven (7) calendar days prior to the date of pre-Bid meeting through e-mail to all the potential Bidders who obtained/acquired the Bidding Document and who may choose to attend through video conference.
